- **Versailles:** My \$8 Cuban sandwich was massive and shareable.
- **Coyo Taco:** The \$5 elote rocked. Tacos are \$9–\$13, but happy hour can save you.
- **La Camaronera:** Seafood specials (\$~\$11–\$12) were fresh and filling.

- **Wynwood Marketplace:** \$5 tacos from food trucks were my daily obsession.

**Budgets (4 Days):**

- **Solo:** \$20–\$30/day. Total: \$80–\$120.
- **Couple:** \$40–\$60/day. Total: \$160–\$240.

- **South Beach:** Free swims were my happy place.
- **Wynwood Walls:** I snapped awesome pics at the free murals.
- **Little Havana Walking Tour:** A \$15 tour brought Cuban history to life.
- **Venetian Pool:** A unique swim (\$11–\$21 for non-residents) with waterfalls and grottos, reopening fall 2025. Residents pay \$5–\$6.
- **Zoo Miami:** \$15 Mondays were a steal; regular \$25.95/adult.

## 5 Sample 4-Day Affordable Itinerary

  - Afternoon: Lunch at La Camaronera (\$~\$11–\$12 specials). Explore Calle Ocho.
  - Evening: Dinner at Versailles (\$3 pastelitos). Budget: \$20–\$30 food, \$5–\$10 transit.
- **Day 4: Coral Gables & Downtown** (\$30–\$50/solo)
  - Morning: Splash at Venetian Pool (\$11–\$21, non-residents; reopens fall 2025).
  - Afternoon: Free Metro Mover to Bayside Marketplace. Lunch at food trucks (\$5–\$8).
  - Evening: Dinner at Wynwood Marketplace (\$5–\$8). Budget: \$15–\$25 food, \$0–\$5 transit, \$11–\$21 activity.

**Total (Solo):** \$100–\$200 for 4 days (excluding stay, flights).

*Tip:* Couples double costs (\$200–\$400); families multiply by 4 (\$400–\$800). Mix free activities to save.

- **Solo:** I stayed in a \$30 dorm, ate \$5–\$10 meals, and used free transit. Total: \$~\$58–\$98/day.

**Flights:** Solo: \$100–\$250; Family (4): \$400–\$1,000.
