Key Biscayne: Best for Families

Key Biscayne, 5 miles from Downtown Miami, is the **best Miami island** for families. Cross the Rickenbacker Causeway (\$2.25 SunPass, \$3.50 Toll-by-Plate) and enjoy:

- **Crandon Park:** 2-mile beach with cabanas (\$40/day), carousel (\$~2).
- **Bill Baggs State Park:** 1825 lighthouse, trails, picnic spots (\$8/vehicle).
- **Activities:** Kayak (\$25/hour), tennis (\$10/hour), golf (\$100–200/round).
- **Dining:** Rusty Pelican (\$15–30/meal).
- **Solo Cost:** \$~50–100/day (toll \$2.25–3.50, park \$8, kayak \$25, dining \$15–30).

- **Activities:** Cycling (\$15/hour), jogging (free), yacht tours (\$200/hour).
- **Access:** Venetian Causeway (\$3.00 SunPass, \$3.75 Toll-by-Plate) or free Miami Beach Trolley.

- **Venetian Islands:** 5 min via Venetian Causeway (\$3.00 SunPass, \$3.75 Toll-by-Plate). Free Miami Beach Trolley.
- **Watson Island:** 5 min via MacArthur Causeway (no toll). Bus 120 (\$2.25, 10 min).
- **Keystone Islands:** 15 min via NE 123rd St (no toll). Bus 107 (\$2.25, 30 min).
- **Bahamas Ferries:** Depart from Fort Lauderdale (~30 miles), not Miami (baleariacaribbean.com).

Savings Tip: Use the GO Miami-Dade Transit app for bus/trolley routes.
