## Where to Get Your Car Rental in Miami

[leftmargin=\*]**Miami International Airport (MIA):** The MIA Rental Car Center (3900 NW 25th St) has Budget, Avis, Enterprise, and more. Hop on the MIA Mover from the terminal (3rd floor, pink signs) for a quick 4-minute ride. It’s open 24/7, but some desks close 11 PM–5 AM. **Miami Beach & Downtown:** SIXT and Turo offer pick-ups in South Beach or Downtown, with some delivering to your hotel or Airbnb. **Off-Airport Lots:** Budget-friendly companies like ACE or Zezgo shuttle you from MIA’s Rental Car Center to nearby locations. Call ahead to confirm pick-up times.

## Driving Tips for Miami in 2025

## Costs and Fees for Car Rental in Miami
