Getting to Miami Zoo & Parking

The **Miami Zoo** is at 12400 SW 152 St, Miami, FL 33177, about 20 miles from Downtown. Here's how to get there:

- By Car: 30 minutes from South Beach via FL-874. Parking costs \$10 per day, not free as some websites claim.
- **Public Transit**: Take Metrorail to Dadeland South (\$2.25), then Bus 152 (\$2.25) or Bus 52 to SW 152 St & SW 94 Ave, transferring to Bus 152. Total ~\$4.50 round-trip, about 1 hour. Use the Miami-Dade Transit app for schedules, as routes vary by day.
- **Rideshare**: Lyft or Uber from Downtown costs ~\$25–\$35.

Savings Tip: Skip the \$10 parking fee with transit. Check the Miami-Dade Transit app for routes.

- Pack Snacks: Meals cost \$10–\$15. Bring water for refill stations.
