1 What Makes The Setai Miami Beach Unique?

The Setai Miami Beach, at 2001 Collins Avenue, is a luxury hotel with 130 rooms and suites in a 1936 Art Deco landmark and a 40-story tower. Designed by Jean-Michel Gathy, it features black granite floors, French limestone, and Shanghai brick accents, creating a serene Asian vibe. I loved the three infinity pools (75°F, 85°F, 90°F) and private beach with cushioned daybeds. A mandatory resort fee (\$45/night, plus tax) covers Wi-Fi, two beach chairs, one umbrella, two water bottles, pool access, fitness center, and concierge services. Amenities include the Valmont Spa (THÉMAÉ treatments, \$150–\$1,300), a 24-hour gym, and dining at Jaya, Ocean Grill, The Setai Beach Kitchen, and Courtyard Bar. It's 0.5 miles from Lincoln Road and 1 mile from the Art Deco District. The Setai Miami Beach earns a 9.0/10 on Booking.com (1,234 reviews) and ranks 7/211 on Tripadvisor (4.5/5, 2,224 reviews). It's a Forbes Travel Guide Five-Star winner for 10 years, per Condé Nast Traveler. Some guests note high dining costs and occasional service delays. Renovations (July 15–November 1, 2025) may affect some areas, but noise is minimized.

My Experience: The warmest pool and a sunset cocktail at the Courtyard Bar felt like paradise.

3 My Stay at The Setai Miami Beach

I stayed in a Studio Suite City View with a Duxiana king bed, Frette linens, and a marble bathroom with rainfall shower and Acqua di Parma toiletries. Check-in at 4 PM was seamless, with staff offering iced tea. The Valmont Spas Ayurvedic massage (\$250) was pure bliss. The Setai Miami Beachs private beach and infinity pools made my stay exceptional. Heres how to make yours unforgettable.

Quick Answer: A Studio Suite at The Setai Miami Beach costs \$556–\$1,500/night, with Wi-Fi and beach access included in the \$45/night resort fee.

4 3-Day Itinerary at The Setai Miami Beach

Heres my 2025 itinerary for a couple at The Setai Miami Beach:

- **Day 1: South Beach Serenity**

Check into The Setai Miami Beach (\$556–\$1,500/night). Walk to Lincoln Road (10 min, free). Shop and dine at Time Out Market (\$30–\$60 for 2). Relax by the 90°F infinity pool (free, resort fee). *Cost:* \$586–\$1,560.

Lounge on the private beach (chairs, umbrella included in resort fee). Sip cocktails at Courtyard Bar (\$20–\$40 for 2). Check out by 12 PM (late checkout on request, ~\$50). *Cost:* \$20–\$40.

My Story: The beachs daybeds and Setai Beach Kitchen snacks made my last day relaxing.

5 Navigating The Setai Miami Beach

The Setai Miami Beach is guest-friendly. Heres what to know:

- **Check-In/Out:** Check-in is at 4 PM (3 PM early check-in possible, subject to availability), check-out by 12 PM. Late check-out costs ~\$50 (per Expedia). Staff are attentive, though peak times may cause delays (Tripadvisor). I checked in at 3:30 PM and got a room upgrade.

- **Transport:** 17 km from Miami International Airport (15–20 min, \$25–\$40 Lyft). Fort Lauderdale Airport (FLL) is 45 km (40 min, \$50–\$70). A free trolley to Lincoln Road stops nearby (every 15 min). The 150 bus from MIA costs \$5 (40 min, 200 ft from hotel). I used the trolley to visit Ocean Drive for free.
- **Parking:** Valet parking is \$49/night (in/out privileges, per thesetaihotels.com). Public lots nearby cost \$2/hour but fill up fast. I paid \$49/night for valet, which was convenient despite a 5-minute wait.
- **Resort Fee:** A mandatory \$45/night (plus tax) fee covers Wi-Fi, two beach chairs, one umbrella, two water bottles (replenished daily), three infinity pools (75°F, 85°F, 90°F), fitness center, and concierge services. Some guests find dining costs high, but I used the beach chairs and Wi-Fi daily.
- **Amenities:** Three infinity pools, private beach with daybeds and Setai Beach Kitchen (snacks, \$10–\$20), Valmont Spa (\$150–\$1,300), 24-hour gym, Jaya (Asian cuisine), Ocean Grill (Mediterranean), Courtyard Bar (cocktails, small plates), and concierge services (e.g., yacht charters, \$500+/hour). Accessibility includes ramps and ADA-compliant suites. Complimentary yoga classes (Friday–Sunday) on the beach are a perk. Renovations (July 15–November 1, 2025) may affect some areas, but noise is minimized.
- **Pet Policy:** One dog up to 20 lbs is allowed, no fee. Cats are not permitted, and dogs must not be left unattended. A grassy pet relief area is on-site. Condo rentals may charge \$250. I saw a guest with a small dog by the pool, well-behaved and welcomed.
- **Tip:** Request a tower suite (20th floor+) for ocean views and less street noise. Book spa treatments early to avoid waitlists.

Quick Answer: The Setai Miami Beach offers 4 PM check-in, valet parking at \$49/night, a \$45/night resort fee (Wi-Fi, beach chairs, pools), and allows one dog (up to 20 lbs, no fee).

6 Tips for Booking The Setai Miami Beach

My stay taught me how to book The Setai Miami Beach smartly:

- **Ocean Suites:** Select packages include free airport transfers and breakfast (Jaya or in-suite). I got breakfast included, saving \$60/day.

My Tip: Book a “bed and breakfast” package for Jayas Grand Breakfast.

7 Costs at The Setai Miami Beach

- **Room Rates** (Per Night, 2025):
 - Studio Suite: \$556–\$1,500.
 - Ocean Suites: \$1,200–\$3,000.
 - Penthouse: \$5,000–\$10,000 (10,000 sq. ft., rooftop pool).
- **Additional Fees:**
 - Resort Fee: \$45/night (plus tax) includes Wi-Fi, two beach chairs, one umbrella, two water bottles, pools, gym, concierge.
 - Valet Parking: \$49/night (in/out privileges).
 - Incidentals: Credit card hold, released post-checkout.
 - Breakfast: \$30–\$50/person at Jaya (included in select Ocean Suite rates).
 - Spa: \$150–\$1,300 (e.g., Nepalese Body Polish, \$250).
- **Dining:** Jaya (\$50–\$100 for 2), Ocean Grill (\$60–\$120 for 2), Courtyard Bar (\$20–\$40 for 2), Setai Beach Kitchen (\$10–\$20 for 2).
- **Activities:** Jet skiing (\$50–\$100/hour), yacht charters (\$500+/hour).

My Experience: My \$750 suite included Wi-Fi and pool access via the resort fee. Jayas Thai curry was a standout.

Quick Answer: A 3-night stay at The Setai Miami Beach costs \$1,668–\$4,500 (room only), plus \$135 resort fee and \$147 valet parking.

8 Budget Calculator for a Couple

For a couple (3 days, excluding room):
