Top 10 Must-See Attractions in Key West

These iconic spots define the Key West experience and should be on everyone's itinerary, Below is the top 10 things to do in key west:

1. Southernmost Point Buoy

No visit is complete without a photo here. This concrete marker sits just 90 miles from Cuba and is the most photographed spot in Key West. Expect lines during peak hours — go early or late for fewer crowds.

2. Mallory Square Sunset Celebration

Every evening before sunset, locals and tourists gather for a festive celebration featuring **jugglers, fire-eaters, musicians**, and street food vendors. It's the best place to watch the sun dip into the Gulf.
